

### **Get Started**

- Research similar nonprofits.
- Get training in nonprofit organization and management.
- Create a mission statement for your nonprofit (purpose, method, clients).
- Choose a name, research availability and apply for a reserved name with the Virginia State Corporation Commission.



### **Get Organized**

- Recruit and establish a Board of Directors.
- Recruit an incorporator to sign your organization's articles of incorporation.
- Appoint a registered agent to receive legal documents for your organization.

### Register

- □ File Articles of Incorporation with the Virginia State Corporation Commission
- Draft bylaws and conflict of interest policies as governing documents for your nonprofit.

Note: It is important to remember that an organization's bylaws and conflict-of-interest policy must be approved and adopted to receive 501(c)3 status from the IRS.

□ Hold an organizational meeting to elect directors, appoint officers and approve the employment structure for the nonprofit. The Board of Directors will approve the bylaws and conflict-of-interest policy, and other resolutions necessary to the creation of the organization.

## Taxes and Licenses

- Apply for an Employer Identification Number (EIN) from the IRS.
- Meet requirements for a Virginia nonstock corporation in order to receive state tax exemptions (form NP-1).
- Consult the IRS and a CPA experienced in helping nonprofits to determine your appropriate tax designation.
- Contact the Fairfax County Department of Tax Administration to determine if your nonprofit qualifies for property or business tax exemptions.

# Taxes and Licenses (continued)

- ☐ File an initial registration statement with the Virginia Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (VDACS) before soliciting funds or donations.
- Obtain a license from the Fairfax County Consumer Affairs Division before soliciting donations in the county.

Note: Nonprofits registered with VDACS are exempt from county licensure for one year or until their VDACS registration expires, whichever comes first.



IRS Tax Exemption \$275-\$600 (depends on form type and organization's tax designation)
Virginia Retail Sales and Use Tax Exemptions Application Free
VDACS Charitable Organization • Registration • Annual fee \$30-\$325 (depends on gross contributions for the year)
